Care coordination aims to improve patient outcomes through cooperation and information-sharing among health care providers and specialists. [NR 504 Week 3 Reflective Essay](#) also reduces fragmentation of care between different providers.

Despite the advantages of care coordination, there are still many challenges that nurses encounter when delivering this service. These include balancing the patient's needs against the resources available in the community and finding a solution that is cost-effective.

As a result, nurses need to incorporate ethical decision-making practices into their coordinated care plans. These practices are based on respect, fairness, responsibility, truthfulness, dignity, and accountability.

Care Coordination Presentation to Colleagues 3

Care coordination ensures that the needs of a patient are met ahead of time and that the right information is shared with the people involved in delivering that care. This reduces snafus involving lost records and ensures that patients receive safe, effective care.

Throughout a person's care journey, they will encounter multiple transitions between different locations and providers. These may include moving from an acute care hospital to a rehabilitation facility, switching from one specialist to another, or simply changing health needs as they age.

Nurses can play a vital role in the [nurs fpx 4050 assessment 3](#) process. They must be aware of community resources, ethical considerations, policy issues, cultural norms, safety, and the physiological needs of patients.

In your presentation, address the following competency areas: Explain the rationale for coordinated care plans based on ethical decision making; Explain how health care policies affect patient-centered care; and Identify the potential impact of specific health care policy provisions on outcomes and patient experiences. Raise awareness of the nurse's vital role in the coordination and continuum of care in a

video-recorded presentation.

Care Coordination Presentation to Colleagues 4

Your nurse manager has asked you to develop a presentation for your nursing colleagues to help them understand the basics of care coordination. This will allow your team to take on an expanded role in managing the care coordination process and improving patient outcomes in your community care center.

Your presentation should be 20 minutes in length and address the fundamental principles of care coordination and how they can impact patient outcomes. [care coordination presentation to colleagues 2](#) also present the role of nurses in the coordination and continuum of care.

You should create a detailed narrative script for your presentation, approximately 4-5 pages in length, and record a video of your presentation. This will raise awareness of your important role in the coordination and continuum of care, as well as support the importance of professional communication skills in nursing practice.

Your presentation should include an explanation of how health care policies affect patient-centered care and discuss the effect of ethical decision making on coordinated care. You should also provide evidence of best practices for a health care concern that you selected and identify available community resources for a safe and effective continuum of care.

Care Coordination Presentation to Colleagues 5

Your nurse manager has observed your effectiveness as a care coordinator and has asked you to develop a presentation on the basics of care coordination for other staff nurses.
